



## **Vital Information and Rules for the Track Days**





**PLEASE NOTE THAT NO INSURANCE IS INCLUDED FOR YOUR VEHICLE**

**YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE CIRCUIT WITHOUT HAVING  
SIGNED ON AND ATTENDED THE BRIEFING**

The event is not a race or a time trial it is an opportunity for you to take your own vehicle around the Donington circuit and gain a different perspective of the track.

- Each driver must have a valid full car license, and/or ACU Competition License/MSA Competition License.
- A 98dBA noise limit will be strictly enforced, on silenced days. After market road legal systems will be allowed provided they conform to the above. You will be asked to leave the circuit if you are found to be over the noise limit.
- Passengers are allowed in cars but front seat only (over 16's only and for an additional £30)
- All drivers and passengers must wear crash helmets before being permitted on the track. Helmets are not provided by Donington Park. If you are in an open car (e.g. a Caterham) then you will need to wear a full face helmet or alternatively, an open face helmet will be ok provided you wear eye protection goggles.
- Your helmet must be a proper motorsport or road helmet. You will not be allowed out on track with a skiing or skateboarding helmet.
- All cars must have towing eyes on both front and rear.
- Any driver who we feel is not conducting themselves in a proper manner will be asked to leave the circuit.
- All drivers and passengers must complete the indemnity form and hand it in at sign on.
- Whilst the sighting sessions are taking place 'THERE WILL BE NO OVERTAKING'.
- A speed limit of 10mph is in operation at all times within the pit lane/paddock and in public areas.
- Consumption of alcohol or drugs is not permitted.
- No animals are permitted at the circuit.

### **Flag System**

	SLOW DOWN, leave circuit, report to race control
	SLOW DOWN, session stopped, do not overtake and leave the circuit where directed
	Extreme caution, hazard ahead do not overtake
	End of session, proceed to exit

### **Circuit Safety and Discipline**

#### **MOTORSPORT CAN BE DANGEROUS PLEASE READ AND COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- DECISIONS MADE BY DONINGTON PARK STAFF ARE FINAL
- WATCH AND OBEY ALL FLAG/LIGHT SIGNALS – CONTACT US IF YOU ARE UNSURE ABOUT ANY SIGNALS
- SLOW DOWN AT END OF SESSION AND WATCH FOR SIGNALS DIRECTING YOU OFF THE CIRCUIT
- DANGEROUS CONDUCT ON OR OFF THE CIRCUIT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED
- DONINGTON PARK RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY CLIENT/VEHICLE FROM THE CIRCUIT
- UNDER 16'S ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE PITS OR PIT SIGNALLING AREA
- NO HAND HELD VIDEO CAMERA'S IN VEHICLES
- OVERTAKE ON THE STRAIGHT ONLY
- OVERTAKE ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE TRACK
- USE YOUR MIRRORS AT ALL TIMES
- ON YOUR FIRST LAP OF THE CIRCUIT DO NOT ATTEMPT TO GO FAST LET YOUR ENGINE WARM UP FIRST
- SPINNING, RACING OTHER VEHICLES OR DRIVING DANGEROUSLY WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM TRACK

- PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY IN THE PADDOCK AREAS – REMEMBER THAT SPECTATORS WILL BE PRESENT
- WHEN LEAVING THE TRACK YOU MUST USE THE PIT LANE

### **Please read the additional information below:**

- All passengers must sign a separate indemnity form before going onto the circuit.
- All participants must attend a full briefing of track rules and track behavior before going out onto the circuit and track behavior is monitored throughout the day from Race Control.
- Doesn't matter what car you have (road or race etc) but the car needs to be road worthy and conform to the Donington Park noise standard. This is 98dba measured at drive-by.
- If unsure of the above this can be ascertained at your local MOT station, loosely a static test of 101dba is equivalent.
- We do not provide insurance for our track days; this is down to the individual. Insurance is not compulsory, however we do advise you, that it is in your best interest to make sure you are covered, in the event of an accident which could result in damage to you and your car.
- Marshals and medical crews are provided on all our days.
- Anyone you wish to bring along to a track day event as a spectator is free of charge, unless otherwise stated.
- Catering facilities are provided on all our dates.

### **Cancellation Policy**

#### **All cancellations must be sent in writing**

- 1. With at least 7 days' notice a full refund may be given.**
- 2. With less than 7 days, but more than 48 hours' notice a credit may be given.**
- 3. With less than 48 hours NO refund or credit will be given.**

- A credit note is valid for 12 months from the original test date.
- Please note: When a credit note has been used as payment for a booking, no refund or credit will be given in the case of a second cancellation.
- Refunds will not be given if your car does not comply with the noise regulations (98db limit – quiet day).
- Refunds will not be given for cancellations of extra drivers or passengers.
